



# Tiger face-painting

### You'll need

- Somebody to paint your face!
- A sponge
- Yellow, orange, black and white face paints
- A face painting brush

### How to do it

- 01 Wet the sponge and use it to cover the bottom of the face (from below the nose to the jaw-line), with yellow paint.
- 02 Sponge the top of the face with orange paint.
- 03 Paint a wide 'moustache' under the nose and across the top lip in white paint.
- 04 Draw white spiky eyebrows above each eye and some white stripes on the forehead.
- 05 Add extra white stripes along the jaw.
- 06 Colour the tip of the nose black.
- 07 Add black strokes to the white eyebrows and some next to the white marks on the forehead.
- 08 Do the same between the white lines on the jaw.
- 09 Paint a line from the middle of the nose to the middle of the top lip, and add black dots on the white moustache.
- 10 Finish with whiskers on each side. Roarrrr!
